 - New testing required by State of California. Bracewell will perform testing for an additional \$50.00 per test (outside original contract).

4) Drought

- Terry Adams suggested calling Stetson to discuss the large water consumption by Camp Glenwood.
- Water master is preparing a letter to all customers if the drought continues.
- Flow gauge is at an all-time low since installed in 1970.
- Nicholas confirmed we cannot charge additional cost for consumers who do not conserve.
