 - County explained how account 5456 has not used 91.6% of revenue. 91.6% of the entire budget for this account has been allocated for use throughout the fiscal year.
 - Capital expenditures report; shows the new treated water meter and the replacement sensaphone datalogging/alarm system have been installed at the treatment plant .
 - The CSA7 column on the Capital Expenditures Report is a future funding source.
 - CSA7 received 45 trips of raw water trucked in to our water system, resulting in a cost of \$18,000.00 during the winter months.
- 3) Capital Improvements, Compliance:
 - CSA7 is required to repair all "water break areas" and return them back to existing condition.
 - Patricia O'Neal will follow up with County for clarification of additional raw water source; Committee desires compliance with the decree be a top priority.
 - Patricia O'Neal will follow up with County, if CSA7 has the money why not complete priority #1 (on CIP and Project Prioritization Report) instead of over a three-year period.
 - Looking for input from County on CIP and Project Prioritization status and recommended time frame.
